Since starting operations in 1997, Dress for Success has expanded to almost 150 cities in 25 countries and has helped more than 1.3 million women work towards self-sufficiency.

Wear Red & Empower



Ten Steps to Empower Her Fundraising Success (and your checklist)

Use these ten steps to ensure your Empower Her campaign is a success, whether you're baking, moving, reading, or getting creative to support women entering the workforce this November.

- **1. Choose Your Empower Her Activity:** Decide which Empower Her activity resonates with you the most. Whether you're taking part in Bake to Empower, Move to Empower, Read and Empower, or creating your own DIY fundraiser, pick an activity that excites you and is easy to share with your network.
- **2. Set Your Fundraising Goal Be ambitious but realistic!** Set a target that motivates you and your supporters. Every contribution makes a difference.
- **3. Register Your Fundraiser on Funraisin:** Head over to Funraisin to create your personalized fundraising page for Empower Her. Share your story, explain which activity you've chosen, and let people know how their donations will support women across Australia.
- **4. Start with Your Own Donation:** Make the first donation on your Funraisin page to show your commitment and inspire others to follow. A strong initial donation—if possible, \$50 or more—can set the tone for the rest of your campaign.
- **5. Reach Out to Family and Friends:** Tell your close friends and family about your Empower Her activity and ask for their support. Whether you're challenging yourself to bake, move, or get creative, let them know why this campaign is important to you.



- **6. Share Your Campaign at work:** Let your colleagues and boss know about your Empower Her fundraiser. Ask your employer if they'd consider matching donations or sponsoring your activity. Sharing your campaign in workplace newsletters or emails can also help you reach more supporters.
- 7. Get Creative with Local Businesses: Approach local businesses that you frequent —like your gym, cafe, or bookstore—and ask if they'd like to contribute to your campaign. They might donate, offer prizes, or help spread the word about your Empower Her activity.
- **8. Use Social Media to Amplify Your Impact:** Post regularly about your Empower Her activity on social media. Share updates on how your Bake to Empower challenge went, photos of your progress for Move to Empower, or your favorite reads for Read and Empower. Engaging your audience online will help you reach more people and encourage more donations.
- **9. Ask for Donations Beyond Your Network:** Share your Funraisin page widely. If you're reading or running for Empower Her, reach out to local community groups, schools, or social clubs and ask them to donate or participate. You can also ask them to host mini-fundraisers of their own to support your goal.
- **10. Follow Up After Your Challenge** Once you've completed your activity, update your donors and share the impact of their contributions. Thank them for supporting you and, if you're close to your goal, send a final call for donations—people may still want to help you hit your target!

Registering Your Funraisin Page

Anyone can fundraise to help us achieve our goal with fundraising efforts instantly feeding into our 'Raised So Far' amount on our campaign homepage.

Get started:

- 1. Start your fundraising page by clicking on a fundraising activity you want to register for. See our <u>Fundraise with us</u> page. Simply fill out the registration details, and a page will be instantly created for you. Complete Step 2 if you want to set up a Team where other fundraising pages can be linked to yours.
- 2. Tailor your page with your:
 - Logo or photo to upload as your profile photo
 - A title for your fundraising page
 - A short description about why you want to support Dress for Success and the Empower Her Campaign. Personal stories have the best impact in encouraging others to join you
 - If you want to use your own cover image on the page, a jpeg image over 1400px wide works best.

Once your registration is complete, you will be given a unique URL to share with your network and community.
